Though it's no longer headline news, the Central Texas communities impacted by the flash flooding over the July 4th weekend continue the work of putting their lives and homes back together under the tremendous weight of loss and grief.

In ADRN's 16-years of experience, we've learned the "cycles" of disaster response. The initial emergency response is followed by the long-term recovery stage. While our initial response efforts continue, we are also engaging in the long-term recovery stage across the impacted zones.

**The financial needs are significant.** In Travis County alone, 93 houses were impacted, some completely destroyed. Imagine if it took \$20,000 to get a family back on their feet...and multiply that by 93 for just one county. As we assess the work that needs to be done, the numbers continue to climb.



Immediate needs also continue—for example, children will be heading back to school soon, and those who have lost everything need clothes, shoes, and school supplies.

### Volunteer Deployment & Coordination

Logistics, staff, fuel, and supplies for volunteers serving in muck-out, debris removal, and cleanup operations

### Crisis Call Center & Case Intake

Technology, training, and staff oversight to operate a remote call center to intake and triage the needs of survivors

### Survivor Support & Emergency Needs

Gift cards, emergency housing assistance, hygiene kits, and other critical items for families displaced or severely affected

### Longer-Term Recovery

Case management, spiritual and emotional care, and survivor resource navigation over the next 30-90 days
