We’re grateful to share that ADRN has implemented a **Coordinated Disaster Response** to set up a Point of Distribution at **Round Mountain Baptist Church** and a

Volunteer Reception Center at Plain Elementary School to serve the **Travis County/Sandy Creek** area.

In **Williamson County**, our team is operating and actively **providing physical, emotional and spiritual care** also identifying next steps for support in a **Multi Agency Resource Center**.

We're also standing alongside our partners in **Kerr County** as assessments continue, preparing to respond with **strategic physical, emotional, and spiritual care** in the days ahead.

Thank you for your continued prayers, support, and willingness to serve—together, we're bringing hope into crisis.



Since the National Guard presence in the Sandy Creek area decreased by half as of 7/13, the need for additional volunteers is even more urgent. **Volunteers are also needed** at **ADRN Headquarters in Austin** to assemble hygiene kits and clean-up buckets for distribution.

**The need here is tremendous**, and the families we are ministering to are extremely grateful for the assistance, prayer, and comfort they are receiving. **Please give generously today to help with this ongoing work.**

## HOW FUNDS WILL BE DEPLOYED IN THE COMING DAYS AND WEEKS

### Volunteer Deployment & Coordination

Logistics, staff, fuel, and supplies for volunteers serving in muck-out, debris removal, and cleanup operations

### Crisis Call Center & Case Intake

Technology, training, and staff oversight to operate a remote call center to intake and triage the needs of survivors

### Survivor Support & Emergency Needs

Gift cards, emergency housing assistance, hygiene kits, and other critical items for families displaced or severely affected.

### Longer-Term Recovery



Case management, spiritual and emotional care,  
and survivor resource navigation over the next  
30-90 days
